### Rich Tea Biscuits

**INGREDIENTS:** Fortified Wheat Flour (**Wheat** Flour, Calcium Carbonate, Niacin, Iron, Thiamin), Sugar, Palm Oil, Partially Inverted Sugar Syrup, **Barley** Malt Extract, Raising Agents: Sodium Bicarbonate, Ammonium Carbonate: Salt, Emulsifier: Mono- and Diacetyl Tartaric Acid Esters of Mono- and Diglycerides of Fatty Acids.

### Strawberry Laces Sweets

**INGREDIENTS:** Glucose-Fructose Syrup, Wheat Flour, Sugar, Dextrin (Wheat), Dextrose, Palm Oil, Acid: Citric Acid; Concentrated Strawberry Juice, Concentrated Blackcurrant Juice, Fruit and Vegetable Concentrates (Apple, Pumpkin, Radish, Tomato), Flavouring, Glazing Agent: Hydroxypropyl cellulose; Antioxidants: Tocopherol-Rich Extract, Ascorbic Acid.

### Rainbow Decorating Icing x6 19g

**INGREDIENTS** Sugar, Glucose Syrup, Water, Maltodextrin, Vegetable Oil (Palm), Whey Powder (**Milk**), Emulsifier (Acetic Acid Esters of Mono- and Diglycerides of Fatty Acids), Colours (Carmine, Lutein, Patent Blue V, Curcumin)

### Icing Sugar

**INGREDIENTS:** White Cane Sugar (97%), Anti Caking Agent: Maize Starch
