<p>Maths</p> 	<p>To subtract across 10. To be able to find 10 more or 10 less than a number. To add and subtract 10s.</p>
<p>Handwriting</p> 	<p>To write numbers to ten with correct formation.</p>
<p>PE – Games</p> 	<p>To throw and catch a ball from a stationary position, on the move and in different ways.</p> <p>To create a throwing and catching game with a partner.</p>
<p>PE – Gymnastics</p> 	<p>To apply and explore different balances using large apparatus.</p>
<p>PSHE</p> 	<p>To understand that whether you are a boy or a girl, you can learn any skill. To know that all jobs are open to anyone.</p> <p>To begin to understand gender stereotypes in the context of what jobs and activities boys and girls, or men and women, are expected to do.</p>
<p>Reading</p> 	<p><u>Little Wandle group reading</u> We will be reading and enjoying books in small groups this week focusing on word reading, prosody and comprehension.</p>
